Declaration by Branch President

On the 16th day of December 2016, I, Scott Weber, Branch President of the Police Federation of Australia, New South Wales Police Branch of 154 Elizabeth Street Sydney, declare as follows:

1. In accordance with Rule 52ET of the Police Federation of Australia, New South Wales Police Branch Rules, notice was given to the Branch Executive of the New South Wales Police Branch Executive on 26 October 2016. The notice contained a number of proposed changes to the rules of the Branch for consideration at the Branch meeting. Annexed hereto and marked with the letter "A" is a copy of that Notice.
2. In accordance with Rule 52 ED of the Police Federation of Australia, New South Wales Police Branch Rules, notice was given on 22 November 2016, of an ordinary meeting of the New South Wales Police Branch Executive to be held on 1 December 2016. The meeting was called at the direction of the Branch Administrator in accordance with Rule 52 EK (a). The notice included the time date and place of the meeting, the business to be dealt with at the meeting including the proposed rule changes.
