Rules used for the election:200V: Incorporates alterations of 24 May 2019 [R2019/37]

(replaces rulebook dated 8 May 2018 [R2019/26])

Rules difficult to apply/interpret: Rule 13 and Rule 21(c) (v) are contradictory in regards to holding multiple offices. Rule 13 allows a nominee to hold both the offices of Vice President and Treasurer whereas rule 21(c) (v) states that a nominee cannot be eligible to hold more than one position.

The Returning Officer recommends that this issue be resolved.


